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UPDATE - TSX ALPHA EXCHANGE IMPLEMENTATION DETAILS

This notice is to provide TSX Alpha Exchange ("Alpha") members implementation details related to the planned changes to the Alpha trading model previously announced in Notice # 2014-031 published November 6, 2014 and outlined in the TMX news release <u>TMX Group to Streamline its Equities Trading Offering</u>. These changes proposed in this notice remain subject to the required regulatory approval.

Scope:

- Launch of new revised Alpha including a short order-processing delay (speed bump) / minimum size for post-only / oddlot autofills at NBBO / new hours of operation / migration to Quantum XA platform
- 2. Decommission IntraSpread facility
- 3. Decommission TMX Select

Production Roll-Out

Symbols trading on existing Alpha will be migrated in one phase, tentatively scheduled for Monday, June 1st, 2015.

- Friday, May 29th close of business, all open orders on existing Alpha will be purged. IntraSpread will also be decommissioned.
- Friday, May 29th close of business, TMX Select will be decommissioned.
- Saturday, May 30th Connectivity validation
- Monday, June 1st New Alpha opens at 8:00 a.m. with an empty order book with the inclusion of the speed bump, oddlot auto-fills at NBBO, minimum size for post-only and with revised functionality on TMX Quantum XA platform. New orders may be re-entered at this time.

Connectivity Details

New order entry session bundles are required. Details pertaining to the IP and Port will be disseminated in a subsequent notice. For the purpose of order routing, one session will be required to access all eligible securities.

Production Connectivity Validation

- Production Order Entry sessions will be made available commencing the week of April 24th, 2015. This will allow for validation of client internal firewall changes and session authentication in a controlled fashion.
- Test Stocks will be made available for the sole purpose of validating order entry the week of April 24th, 2015. Prior to sending any test orders, you will need to contact <u>Market Operations</u> at 416-947-4357. Test stocks will need to be uninhibited. Performance testing will not be allowed.

Handling of Open Orders

Open orders will be purged as part of the production migration with batch on Friday, May 29th. Reentering of all order types can be done on Monday, June 1st at 8:00 a.m.

Market Data Feeds

A new multicast group and recovery session will be required as part of the migration. IPs and ports will be disseminated in a subsequent notice. New stream IDs will also be added for the binary feeds.
